



Author Visit by Cressida Cowell



As part of the Festival of Performance and the Arts, the entire Year 7 were invited to participate in a Zoom session with Children's Laureate Cressida Cowell, along with other schools across the country. Cressida Cowell is best known as the author of the "How to Train Your Dragon" series and her new book, "The Wizards of Once". During the session, students learned about where Cowell gets the inspiration for her characters and plot. Some of our Year 7 students recognised names of two of her characters, "Caliban" and "Ariel", from our recent study of "The Tempest".

As part of the Zoom session, the students took part in a Q&A session with Cressida Cowell. She hinted at a desire to write another book in the "How to Train Your Dragon" series, but she is currently busy writing the next book in her new series.

Upcoming Events and Non-Uniform Days


Monday 5th July - Passport Walk for Year 9 - own clothes, packed lunch, and appropriate footwear for a long walk.

Covid Testing Guidance



As you may be aware, South Ribble has been designated as an area of 'enhanced response' due to the rise in cases of Covid-19 in Lancashire and across the North West, driven by the variant first identified in India, now known as Delta.

We know that this variant is more transmissible than previous strains. New data is also emerging that suggests that people infected with the Delta variant – which is now thought to be the dominant strain in the UK – may be at greater risk of being admitted to hospital compared to the Alpha variant, which originated in Kent, although further data is needed to have more confidence in that finding. Public Health England is currently working hard to understand the Delta variant better.

At present, we have been given no further guidance about what we, as a school, need to do in order to support the work of the local authority to reduce the spread of the virus. As you know, we have continued with the use of face coverings in school. We would also like to encourage all students to continue with their twice weekly lateral flow tests - this will help support our efforts to protect our school community and reduce transmission of the virus by detecting asymptomatic cases.

Once we receive any further information about any action the school needs to take, we will be in touch.
