#### Introduction:

BTEC level 2 health and social care course is designed to allow learners to progress to Level 3 qualifications and apprenticeships in health and social care at college.

## How you will learn:

Students will learn how to work with adults and children in health and social care settings and will study 4 different units of work including work experience placement for a week.

#### **Assessment:**

Component 1, Human Lifespan Development and Component 2, Health and social care services and values, are assessed internally through 4 assignments which worth 60% Of the total grade.

Component 3, Health and wellbeing will be assessed through 2 hour written examination in February in year 11 and resit in June worth 40% of the total grade.

This qualification will help to prepare students for virtually any career in any sector especially NHS equipping them with effective health and wellbeing knowledge, organisational ability, and the ability to present their ideas clearly.
