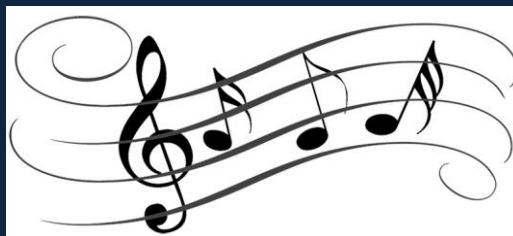

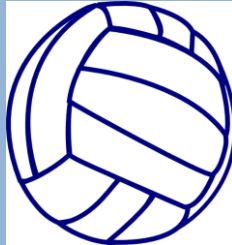

Please make sure that all donations are in school by Tuesday the 14th of December, Thank You.

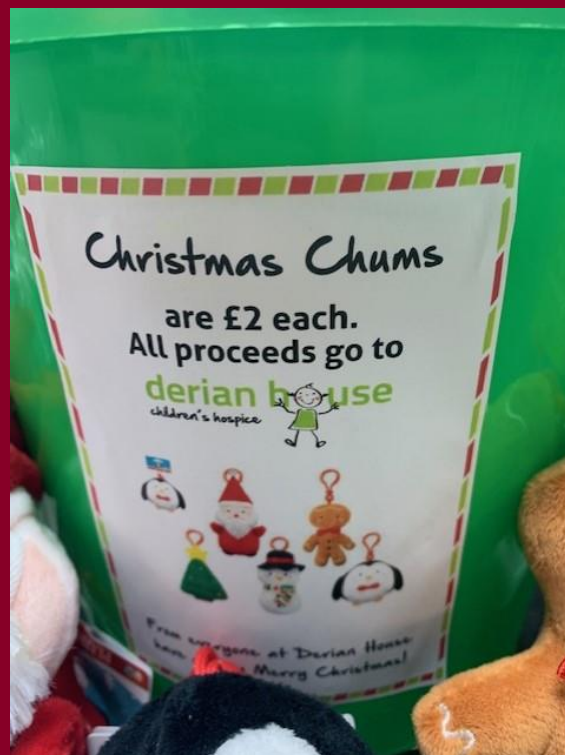

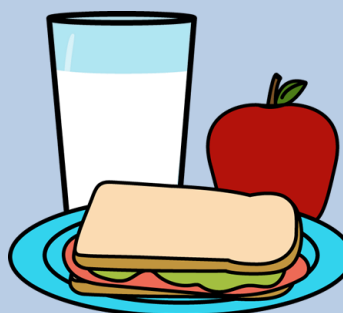
